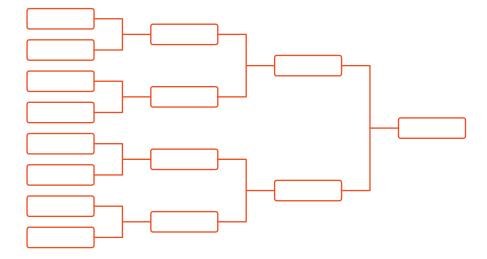
The To-Do Tournament
